APPROVE THE ALTERATION OF RESOLUTION 305/2022 - CONSUN, WHICH REFERS TO THE SYLLABUS REGARDING THE INTERDISCIPLINARY BACHELOR'S IN SCIENCE AND HUMANITIES - CURITIBA CÂMPUS, FACE-TO-FACE FORM, EFFECTIVE AS OF THE 1ST SEMESTER 2023.

The President of the University Council, carrying out the use of his statutory tasks and bearing in mind Report 14/2023 – CAMGRAD approved by the Chamber of Undergraduate Student Affairs in the session on February 16, 2023.

RESOLUTION:

Art. 1 Approve alteration of Resolution 305/2022 – CONSUN, which deals with the syllabus from the Interdisciplinary Bachelor of Science and Humanities – Curitiba Câmpus, face-to-face, effective 1st semester of 2023.

Changes made during the course of the curriculum must be updated permanently and detailed in the course's pedagogical project (PPC).

The course syllabus can include classes and curricular components, with the possibility of the course load being partially or entirely offered online, provided that the total course load does not exceed 40% by the Education Ministry Ordinance 2117, dated December 6, 2019. The Extension course load, as per Resolution 07/2018 - MEC, should fulfilled face-to-face at the activity sites, as required by extension classes.
